The Ghana Grid Company LTD. (GRIDCo) wishes to inform the public that power supply to all affected areas has been fully restored following the system disturbance that occurred on Thursday, 20 August 2026.

The restoration process commenced immediately with GRIDCo's engineers and power sector technical teams working diligently to restore supply to all affected areas. By 12:03 p.m., power had been restored to all affected areas. GRIDCo appreciates the cooperation and support of all stakeholders throughout the restoration process.

GRIDCo will continue to implement measures to strengthen the reliability, stability, and resilience of the transmission network.

Note to Editors:

Ghana Grid Company LTD. (GRIDCo) was incorporated in December 2006 to carry out the economic dispatching and transmission of electricity from facilities of wholesale suppliers (Independent Power Producers [IPPs]) to bulk customers and distribution utilities in Ghana and West Africa. The Company became operational on August 1, 2008, following the transfer of the Transmission System Department and its core staff from VRA to GRIDCo. It operates the National Interconnected Transmission System (NITS). GRIDCo currently transmits electricity to thirty-three (33) Bulk Customers and Distribution Utilities from eleven (11) Wholesale Suppliers, including the Volta River Authority (VRA).
