RE: PETITION OBJECTING TO THE CANDIDACY OF MR. MICHAEL OSEI BOATENG FOR THE OFFICE OF NATIONAL YOUTH ORGANISER — NON-COMPLIANCE WITH THE AGE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENT UNDER ARTICLE 15(4) OF THE PARTY'S CONSTITUTION

We, the undersigned, being card-bearing members of the New Patriotic Party (full particulars and signatures set out in the Schedule of Petitioners attached as Annexure "A"), respectfully submit this petition to the Elections Committee pursuant to the Party's Constitution and the Elections Committee's mandate to vet and determine the eligibility of aspirants seeking national executive office.

1. THE SUBJECT OF THE PETITION

1. This petition concerns the candidacy of Mr. Michael Osei Boateng ("the Aspirant"), who, on Friday August 28, 2026, filed to contest the office of National Youth Organiser at the forthcoming National Executive Elections of the Party.
2. We petition for the Aspirant's disqualification, alternatively for his candidacy to be suspended pending verification, on the ground that he does not meet the age eligibility requirement prescribed for the office (which remains a condition precedent), and we contend that he may have submitted documents to mislead and hoodwink the Committee and the Party at large given that he does not meet the age criteria per the documentary evidence attached to this petition hereto.

2. THE CONSTITUTIONAL AND REGULATORY BASIS

3. Article 15(4) of the Constitution of the New Patriotic Party defines a "youth" as a member of the Party who has not attained the age of forty (40) years. By long-standing Party convention, eligibility to contest the office of National Youth Organiser is tied to this constitutional definition of "youth".
4. We note that at the Party's National Delegates Conference held on 19th July 2025, delegates specifically considered and rejected Motion 54, which sought to reduce the youth age ceiling from forty (40) to thirty-five (35) years, thereby reaffirming the forty (40)-year threshold as the operative standard for the current electoral cycle.
5. It is accordingly posited that age requirement is the fulcrum for determining eligibility for the office of National Youth Organiser and that an aspirant must not have attained the age of forty (40) years as at the time nominations are filed for the National Executive Elections.

3. GROUNDS OF THE PETITION

6. It is the honest belief of the petitioners, held on reasonable grounds, that the Aspirant has, as at the date of filing his nomination, already attained the age of forty (40) years and older, and is therefore not qualified to contest the office of National Youth Organiser.
7. In purported proof of his eligibility, we are of the belief that the Aspirant may have tendered documentary evidence in the affirmative. However, documentary evidence we have attached hereto (Annexure "B"), namely the passport biodata page of the Aspirant, his Ghana Card and SSNIT details unequivocally indicate that he was born in the year AD 1984 and consequently, is more than forty(40) years at the commencement of the electoral process. Particulars of the aforementioned documents relative to the subject matter of this petition are detailed as follows:

8. The petitioners wholly rely on the documents annexed hereto, and are of the opinion that the Committee may undertake its own verification of the subject matter of this petition to

confirm the attached documentary evidence and seek further and better particulars with the agencies responsible for the issuance of these document.

9. In the event that further research reveals alteration of documents ostensibly to hoodwink the Committee and by extension the Party, in support of the Aspirant's nomination, same would constitute grounds for disqualification. It needs stating that this development under Ghanaian law is treated as fraudulent misrepresentation and could potentially bring the name of the Party into disrepute.

4. RELIEF SOUGHT

The petitioners respectfully pray that the Elections Committee for the following reliefs:

10. Suspend further processing of the Aspirant's nomination for the office of National Youth Organiser pending investigation of this petition;
11. Direct the Aspirant to submit his Ghana Card, Passport, and a record of SSNIT biodata and any other primary identification or birth records, for verification;
12. Afford the petitioners and the Aspirant a fair hearing in accordance with the Party's vetting procedures before any final determination is made;
13. Disqualifies the Aspirant from contesting the office of National Youth Organiser should it be established that he has attained the age of forty (40) years, or that he submitted an altered or falsified document(s) to the Party; and
14. Grants such further or other reliefs as the Elections Committee may deem fit and appropriate taking cognizance of the surrounding circumstances and in the interest of justice, protection of the corporate image of the Party and deterrence for such despicable and undemocratic acts.

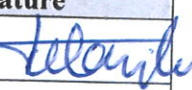
5. CONCLUSION
